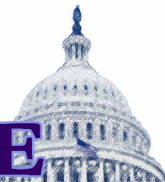

Senate Budget Committee Releases Current Tally of Hurricane-Related Spending

The Senate Budget Committee today released a current tally of congressional legislation related to Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. Total hurricane-related relief enacted or passed by the Senate now totals more than \$101 billion.
