Law Funds New Border Fencing, 1500 Additional Border Patrol Agents, Cracks Down on Illegal Border Tunnels

On Wednesday, President Bush will sign into law legislation providing new resources to secure the border. Some of the House Republicans who led the effort for these border security provisions will hold a press conference Wednesday at the Otay Mesa or El Grande tunnel to highlight these new resources. This legislation includes:

- \$1.2 billion for border fencing, vehicle barriers, technology and infrastructure \checkmark
- 1 \$2.77 billion for the Border Patrol, adding 1500 new Border Patrol agents, for a total of 14.800
- \$1.38 billion for ICE custody operations, adding 6700 detention beds, for a total of 1 27,500
- 1 Provision criminalizing the creation of tunnels to illegally cross the U.S. borders. This legislation, H.R. 4830, passed the House on September 21 by a 422-to-0 margin and was authored by Rep. David Dreier (R-Calif.).
