## HELP AVAILABLE IN MANY PLACES

With tax deadlines approaching, you may have questions about your return. Fortunately, there are many sources of help available if you have questions about any part of the Federal income tax filing process.

The newly redesigned Internal Revenue Service website (<a href="www.irs.gov">www.irs.gov</a>) should be able to answer most of your questions. It provides links to email a question to the IRS if you can't find the information you need. You can also file your taxes online and get your refund in half the time!

## **VITA and TCE Programs**

Free tax return preparation is available for qualified taxpayers through the IRS Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) and Tax Counseling for the Elderly (TCE) programs. Volunteers help prepare basic tax returns for individuals who have low to moderate income. Some sites offer electronic filing at no charge.
