## Possible Amendments to the FY2005 District of Columbia Appropriations Act (H.R. 4850)

The following are potential amendments. Under the open rule (H.Res. 724), new amendments may be offered without notice (although the rule does give priority to those amendments that were pre-printed in the *Congressional Record*). Under the rules of the House, the bill will be read for amendment by paragraph. ### **Amendments Pre-Filed in the *Congressional Record*:**

**Tancredo #1:** Prohibits funds funds from being used to permit voting in DC elections by individuals who are not U.S. citizens.

**Hefley #2:** Reduces total federal appropriations in this bill (other than appropriations required to be made by a provision of law) by \$5,600,000 (1%).
