H.J.Res. _____-To amend H.J.Res. 107, as enacted (Young of Florida)

Please note that the actual text of the resolution was not made available as of 3 PM on the day of floor consideration. The RSC will send out an update if the text deviates from what is expected.

<u>Order of Business</u>: The resolution is scheduled to be considered on Monday, October 04, 2004, under a motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill.

Summary: The resolution would exclude one-time supplemental spending from the funds made available to federal agencies through the recently enacted continuing resolution ("CR"). The CR funds ongoing government activities at the FY04 levels, including supplemental appropriations, through November 20th. However, CBO estimated that the CR, when annualized, would cost \$840.6 billion in FY05 -- \$18.7 billion more than is provided in the FY05 budget resolution. <u>Today's resolution would amend the CR to ensure that the one-time supplemental spending does not reoccur in FY05 and that the CR complies with the budget.</u>

<u>**Committee Action:**</u> H.J.Res. ____ was referred to the Appropriations Committee on October 4, 2004. The committee did not officially consider the resolution.
