**H.R. 5426—Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation Technical
Corrections Act (Young of Alaska)**

Order of Business: The bill is scheduled to be considered on Tuesday, December 7th, subject to unanimous consent.

Summary: H.R. 5426 would make a variety of purely technical changes to the Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation Act of 2004 (Public Law 108-293).

Committee Action: The bill was introduced on December 6, 2004, and immediately referred to the Transportation and Infrastructure Committee, which did not officially consider the legislation.

Cost to Taxpayers: The bill would not affect spending.

Does the Bill Expand the Size and Scope of the Federal Government?: No.

Does the Bill Contain Any New State-Government, Local-Government, or Private-Sector Mandates?: No.
