Congressional Accountability Act

Interns working in Congressman Bill Thomas' office perform services as part of a demonstrated educational program for congressional interns as required by the Congressional Accountability Act.

Dress Code and Office Hours

The dress code is professional; a coat and tie for men; dresses, skirts, and pantsuits are suitable for women. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.

General Duties and Responsibilities

Interns will have the opportunity to learn about current legislation and the operation of the United States Congress. Some of the duties for which interns will be responsible include office duties such as answering phones, sorting mail, filing, assisting in resolving constituent inquiries and working on special projects.

Employment Facts

Congressman Bill Thomas offers volunteer and paid internship positions. Applicants must have a minimum of a 3.00 grade point average and must have completed two years of college in order to be considered for the internship. A stipend of \$1,300.00 is paid for the Washington, D.C. summer program to assist with travel and lodging experiences.

Applicants must submit at least two references. References from professors and teachers or professionals are preferred.

Writing Sample

Applicants must submit a 250-word essay on why they wish to obtain an internship with Congressman Bill Thomas. The essay should include legislative issues of interest and what the applicant would like to gain from this experience.
