Senate HELP Committee Accomplishments 109th Congress

Securing a Lifetime of Opportunity at School, at Work, and at Home

- 37 bills reported out of committee
 - 23 bills passed by the Senate
- 352 nominations reported favorably
- 15 laws signed by President Bush:
- 1. **Pension Protection Act** the biggest revision to pension laws in 30 years; strengthens funding rules to secure the retirements of millions of Americans.
- 2. **MINER Act** first revision to mine safety laws in 28 years; promotes the use of new technologies to improve mine safety and save lives.
- 3. **Deficit Reduction Act** HELP provisions yield \$15.5 billion in savings **after** helping college students by reauthorizing many components of HEA.
- 4. **Perkins Act** modernizes, improves accountability for career and technical education programs.
- 5. **Patient Safety Bill** allows physicians to compare and analyze medical errors without the fear of being sued and without compromising patient safety.
- 6. **Patient Navigator Act** helps poor and older individuals navigate complex health systems with assistance from trained professionals.
- 7. **Medical Device Bill** streamlines FDA review of medical devices and increases safety.
- 8. **Stem Cell Therapeutic and Research Act** establishes a National Cord Blood Stem Cell Bank Network to enable patient match, use and research.
- 9. **Prescription Electronic Reporting Act** establishes or improves upon state controlled substance monitoring programs.
- 10. **State High Risk Pool Funding Extension Act** supports programs to maintain health insurance pools for high risk individuals.
- 11. **Center for Disease Control** extends the maximum duration of voluntary service to the National Foundation for the CDC.
- 12. **Cosmetic Contact Lens** allows the FDA to regulate contacts as medical devices to save evesight.
- 13. **Youthbuild Transfer Act** assists young adults not enrolled in school gain needed education, skills and knowledge while serving their communities.
- 14. **Higher Education Extension** extends provisions of HEA through June 20.
- 15. **Older Americans Act** reauthorizes and improves social services programs for seniors.

We're not finished! Congress needs to act now on these HELP-approved bills:

- Small Business Health Plans (SBHP) reduces health insurance costs and expands coverage by allowing small businesses and trade associations to band together across the nation and offer SBHPs to provide affordable group health coverage.
- Ryan White Care Act Reauthorization ensures that funding follows the patients of HIV/AIDS to populations where the disease is spreading most rapidly.
- **Biodefense and BARDA** establishes bioterrorism, pandemic, and all-hazards protection and preparedness.
- Wired for Health Care Quality Act enhances the adoption of a nationwide interoperable health information technology system to avoid duplicative tests, reduce medical errors, and cut costs.
- Workforce Investment Act trains 900,000 workers to get the skills to secure better paying jobs, improve American economic competitiveness.
- **Higher Education Act** reduces costs, improves access, and increases accountability.
- **Head Start** reauthorizes and improves preschool education programs to ensure more accountability and transparency.
