## A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to expand the definition of firefighter to include apprentices and trainees, regardless of age or duty limitations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Christopher Kangas  
5 Fallen Firefighter Apprentice Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF DEFINITION OF FIREFIGHTER TO**  
2 **INCLUDE APPRENTICES AND TRAINEES.**

3 Section 1204(4) of the Omnibus Crime Control and  
4 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796b(4)) is amend-  
5 ed by inserting “, regardless of age, status as an appren-  
6 tice or trainee, or duty restrictions imposed because of age  
7 or status as an apprentice or trainee,” after “fire depart-  
8 ment”.

9 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

10 The amendment made by this Act shall apply with  
11 respect to deaths and injuries which occur on or after May  
12 4, 2002.
