This week, the U.S. House of Representatives returns for a lame-duck session. It is expected that the remaining nine appropriations bills will be folded into one omnibus spending bill for the remainder of the fiscal year. This is unfortunate because it bypasses regular congressional oversight, and pervents members of Congress from having the opportunity to review and vote on individual funding issues.

I also hope that the House and Senate will be able to reach an agreement on overhauling the intelligence community. We are engaged in a War on Terrorism and it's critical that our intelligence capabilities be strengthened and improved. To accomplish this goal, we need an intelligence director who has the budgetary and personnel authority to change the current system.
