Dear Friends,

While the Bush Administration's budget cuts the funding for important domestic programs to pay for an additional \$70 billion in tax cuts, I am particularly disturbed by proposed cuts to our veterans' health care system.

Since 1999, enrollment in the VA health care system has increased from 4.3 million to approximately 7.4 million in 2004. Yet, funding has not kept pace. Funding for the VA health system has increased by less than 10% since 2001, even though VA officials have testified that annual increases of 13-14% are necessary just to maintain current levels of service.

As America continues to welcome a new generation of veterans home from Iraq and Afghanistan, the Administration recently acknowledged a \$1 billion shortfall in the veterans' health care budget for FY 2005. Last summer, Congress corrected the shortfall for FY 2005, but a \$3 billion shortfall still remains in the FY 2006 budget.

I also am distressed that the proposed FY 2006 budget would cut approximately \$12 million from medical and prosthetic research from FY 2004 levels, just as our soldiers are in more need of such expertise.

Our veterans earned their benefits by protecting and defending us. Their health care is an ongoing responsibility that we should be willing to shoulder.
