Dear Friends,

As the Ranking Democrat on the U.S. Helsinki Commission, I am helping to host a session of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) this week in Washington, D.C. I have been a Commissioner on the U.S. Helsinki Commission since 1993, and I consider the work we have done to address many serious human rights violations to be very important.

Most recently, U.S. Rep. Chris Smith, R-NJ, and I sponsored legislation to deal with the growing problem of human trafficking. The U.S. Department of State estimates that annually 800,000 individuals – mostly women and children – are trafficked across borders. In the United States, between 14,500 and 17,500 individuals fall victim to forced labor and sexual exploitation.

The Trafficking Victims Protection Act, **HR 972**, would focus governmental efforts, particularly by the State Department, the U.S. Agency for International Development and the Department of Defense, on developing effective trafficking prevention strategies for post-conflict and humanitarian emergency situations.

Human trafficking robs people of their dignity and self respect and it's a problem that we must find a better way to combat.
