Total number of bills and resolutions signed into law in August 2004: 22

Total costs of bills signed into law in August 2004:

- Authorizations over five years: \$7.24 billion
- Net change in mandatory spending over five years: -\$56.5 million
- Appropriations for fiscal year 2004: \$28.16 billion
- Appropriations for fiscal year 2005: \$390.91 billion
- Net change in federal revenue over five years: +\$84.0 million
