Robert M. La Follette, Sr. Post Office Building Designation Act

Signed into law: June 17, 2005

Cost: No significant cost to taxpayers

Signed into law: June 29, 2005

Cost: No significant cost to taxpayers

Public Law 109-17

A bill to amend the Agricultural Credit Act of 1987 to reauthorize State mediation programs

Signed into law: June 29, 2005

Cost: Authorizes \$37.5 million over five years.

Public Law 109-18

Patient Navigator Outreach and Chronic Disease Prevention Act

Signed into law: June 29, 2005

Cost: Authorizes \$25.0 million over five years.
