

# **Bills Signed into Law** November 2002

Total number of bills and resolutions signed into law in November 2002: 34

Total costs of bills signed into law in November 2002:

- Authorizations over five years: \$41.3 billion
- Net increase in mandatory spending over five years: \$7.3 billion
- Appropriations for fiscal year 2003: **\$0**
- Net change in federal revenue over five years: -\$9.8 billion

## <u>H.R. 2215</u>

Public Law 107-273

Department of Justice Authorization Act

Signed into law: November 2, 2002

<u>Cost</u>: Specifically authorizes **\$22.03 billion** over five years (not including the authorizations at "such sums as may be necessary," for which cost estimates are unavailable)

Signed into law: November 2, 2002

Signed into law: November 2, 2002

#### H.R. 5596

Public Law 107-276

To amend section 527 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to eliminate notification and return requirements for State and local party committees and candidate committees and avoid duplicate reporting by certain State and local political committees of information required to be reported and made publicly available under State

Signed into law: November 2, 2002

<u>Cost</u>: *Saves* taxpayers **\$5 million** over five years

Public Law 107-277

Enterprise Integration Act

Signed into law: November 5, 2002

Cost: Authorizes \$47 million over five years

To amend the International Organizations Immunities Act to provide for the applicability of that Act to the European Central Bank

Signed into law: November 5, 2002

Education Sciences Reform Act

Signed into law: November 5, 2002

Cost: Authorizes \$3.65 billion over five years

Signed into law: November 6, 2002

Signed into law: November 6, 2002

Cost: Authorizes \$100 million over five years

Public Law 107-282

To establish wilderness areas, promote conservation, improve public land, and provide for high quality development in Clark County, Nevada

Signed into law: November 6, 2002

<u>Cost</u>: No significant cost to taxpayers.

National Medical Emergency Preparedness Act

Signed into law: November 7, 2002

Cost: Authorizes \$100 million over five years

Signed into law: November 7, 2002

#### <u>H.R. 5205</u>

Public Law 107-290

To amend the District of Columbia Retirement Protection Act of 1997 to permit the Secretary of the Treasury to use estimated amounts in determining the service longevity component of the Federal benefit payment required to be paid under such Act to certain retirees of the Metropolitan Police Department of the District of Columbia

Signed into law: November 7, 2002

#### <u>H.R. 5574</u>

Public Law 107-291

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 206 South Main Street in Glennville, Georgia, as the "Michael Lee Woodcock Post Office".

Signed into law: November 7, 2002

Cost: No significant cost to taxpayers

#### <u>S. 1210</u>

Public Law 107-292

To reauthorize the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996

Signed into law: November 13, 2002

<u>Cost</u>: Appropriates **\$3.5 billion** over five years

#### <u>S. 2690</u>

Public Law 107-293

Pledge of Allegiance and National Motto Affirmation Act

Signed into law: November 13, 2002

<u>Cost</u>: No significant cost to taxpayers

Public Law 107-294

Making continuing appropriations for the fiscal year 2003

Signed into law: November 23, 2002

Cost: No new discretionary appropriations over the fiscal year 2002 baseline

<u>S. 1214</u> Public Law 107-295

Maritime Transportation Security Act

Signed into law: November 25, 2002

Cost: Authorizes \$5.2 billion over five years

Public Law 107-296

Homeland Security Act

Signed into law: November 25, 2002

<u>Cost</u>: Authorizes **\$4.5 billion** over five years and increases mandatory spending by **\$5.0** million over five years

Public Law 107-297

Terrorism Risk Protection Act

Signed into law: November 26, 2002

<u>Cost</u>: Increases mandatory spending by **\$7.3 billion** over five years and *reduces* federal revenue by **\$9.5 billion** over five years

Signed into law: November 26, 2002

<u>Cost</u>: No significant cost to taxpayers

Public Law 107-301

To facilitate the use of a portion of the former O'Reilly General Hospital in Springfield, Missouri, by the local Boys and Girls Club through the release of the reversionary interest and other interests retained by the United States in 1955 when the land was conveyed to the State of Missouri

Signed into law: November 26, 2002

<u>Cost</u>: No significant cost to taxpayers

Signed into law: November 27, 2002

Cost: Authorizes \$443.0 million over five years

Public Law 107-304

To amend title 5, United States Code, to allow certain catch-up contributions to the Thrift Savings Plan to be made by participants age 50 or over

Signed into law: November 27, 2002

Cost: Saves taxpayers \$280.0 million over five years

Signed into law: November 27, 2002
