### February 2004

#### H.R. 2264

Public Law 108-200

Congo Basin Forest Partnership Act

Signed into law: February 13, 2004

Cost: Authorizes \$18.6 million in FY2004

#### S. 610

Public Law 108-201

NASA Workforce Flexibility Act

Signed into law: February 24, 2004

Cost: Authorizes \$95 million over five years

#### H.R. 3850

Public Law 108-202

Surface Transportation Extension Act of 2004

Signed into law: February 29, 2004

<u>Cost</u>: Increases contract authority (a mandatory form of budget authority to incur obligations in advance of appropriations) by \$6.2 billion over five years.
