# **Bills Signed into Law**

**July 2004** 

Total number of bills and resolutions signed into law in July 2004: 15

Total costs of bills signed into law <u>in July 2004</u>:

- Authorizations over five years: -\$3.5 billion\*
- Net change in mandatory spending over five years: \$19.0 million
- Appropriations for fiscal year 2004: **\$0**
- Appropriations for fiscal year 2005: \$0
- Net change in federal revenue over five years: -\$113.0 million

# H.R. 3378

Public Law 108-266

Marine Turtle Conservation Act

Signed into law: July 2, 2004

Cost: Authorizes \$25 million over five years

# H.R. 3504

Public Law 108-267

To amend the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act to redesignate the American Indian Education Foundation as the National Fund for Excellence in American Indian Education

Signed into law: July 2, 2004

## H.R. 4322

Public Law 108-268

To provide for the establishment of the headquarters for the Department of Homeland Security in the District of Columbia, to require the transfer of administrative jurisdiction over the Nebraska Avenue Naval Complex in the District of Columbia to serve as the location for the headquarters, to facilitate the acquisition by the Department of the Navy of suitable replacement facilities

Signed into law: July 2, 2004

<u>Cost</u>: Authorizes \$102 million over five years

# S. 1848

Public Law 108-269

To amend the Bend Pine Nursery Land Conveyance Act to direct the Secretary of Agriculture to sell the, Bend Pine Nursery Administration Site in the State of Oregon

Signed into law: July 2, 2004

Public Law 108-271

Cost: Increases mandatory spending by \$19 million over five years

Public Law 108-272

Approving the renewal of import restrictions contained in the Burmese Freedom and Democracy Act of 2003

Signed into law: July 7, 2004

Public Law 108-279

## H.R. 4916

Public Law 108-280

Surface Transportation Extension Act of 2004, Part IV

Signed into law: July 30, 2004

<u>Cost</u>: Decreases contract authority (a mandatory form of budget authority to incur obligations in advance of appropriations) by \$7.2 billion over five years
