Bills Signed into Law May 2003

Total number of bills and resolutions signed into law in May 2003: 9

Total costs of bills signed into law in May 2003:

• Authorizations over five years: \$15.0 billion

• Net increase in mandatory spending over five years: \$27.9 billion

• Appropriations for fiscal year 2003: \$0

• Appropriations for fiscal year 2004: \$0

• Net change in federal revenue over five years: -\$305.1 billion

S. 162

Public Law 108-22

A bill to provide for the use of distribution of certain funds awarded to the Gila River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community

Signed into law: May 14, 2003

<u>Cost</u>: Increases mandatory spending by \$700,000 this year

H.R. 289

Public Law 108-23

To expand the boundaries of the Ottawa National Wildlife Refuge Complex and the Detroit River International Wildlife Refuge

Signed into law: May 19, 2003

Cost: Authorizes \$25.0 million over five years

H.J.Res. 51

Public Law 108-24

Increasing the statutory limit on the public debt

Signed into law: May 24, 2003

Cost: No direct effect on the federal budget

H.R. 1298

Public Law 108-25

United States Leadership Against HIV/AIDS, Tuberculosis, and Malaria Act

Signed into law: May 27, 2003

<u>Cost</u>: Authorizes \$15.0 billion over five years

H.R. 2185

Public Law 108-26

Unemployment Compensation Amendments of 2003

Signed into law: May 28, 2003

<u>Cost</u>: Increases mandatory spending by \$7.9 billion over two fiscal years and increases federal revenues by \$1.0 billion over five years

Public Law 108-27

Jobs and Growth Tax Reconciliation Act

Signed into law: May 28, 2003

<u>Cost</u>: Reduces federal revenues by \$306.1 billion over five years and increases mandatory spending by a net \$20.0 billion over two fiscal years.

<u>S. 243</u>

Public Law 108-28

A bill concerning participation of Taiwan in the World Health Organization

Signed into law: May 29, 2003

<u>Cost</u>: No significant net cost to taxpayers

S. 330

Public Law 108-29

Veterans' Memorial Preservation and Recognition Act

Signed into law: May 29, 2003

<u>Cost</u>: No significant net cost to taxpayers

Public Law 108-30

To amend the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act to extend the availability of funds to carry out the fruit and vegetable pilot program

Signed into law: May 29, 2003

Cost: No new costs to taxpayers
