Signed into law: May 18, 2004

Public Law 108-229

To provide for expansion of Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore

Signed into law: May 28, 2004

Cost: Authorizes \$10 million over five years

Public Law 108-231

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to revise a repayment contract with the Tom Green County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1, San Angelo project, Texas

Signed into law: May 28, 2004

Cost: Increases mandatory spending by \$400,000 over five years

Signed into law: May 28, 2004

Public Law 108-234

To provide for the establishment of campaign medals to be awarded to members of the Armed Forces who participate in Operation Enduring Freedom or Operation Iraqi Freedom
