Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States relating to marriage.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several



- 1 States within seven years after the date of its submission
- 2 for ratification:
- 3 "Article —
- 4 "Section 1. Marriage in the United States shall con-
- 5 sist only of a legal union of one man and one woman.
- 6 "Sec. 2. No court of the United States or of any
- 7 State shall have jurisdiction to determine whether this
- 8 Constitution or the constitution of any State requires that
- 9 the legal incidents of marriage be conferred upon any
- 10 union other than a legal union between one man and one
- 11 woman.
- "Sec. 3. No State shall be required to give effect to
- 13 any public act, record, or judicial proceeding of any other
- 14 State concerning a union between persons of the same sex
- 15 that is treated as a marriage, or as having the legal inci-
- 16 dents of marriage, under the laws of such other State.".
