"(3) the individual is not a lobbyist registered
under the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 (2
U.S.C. 1601 et seq.) or any successor law or a lobbyist who, as an employee of an organization, is covered by the registration of that organization under
that Act or any successor law.".
