LEGISLATIVE LANGUAGE:

The bill includes language preventing the Army Corps of Engineers from supporting activities related to two proposed landfills in Ohio.

The bill includes language designating a lock and dam on the Allegheny River in Pennsylvania as the "C.W. Bill Young Lock and Dam".

The bill makes changes with respect to the Sacramento County Water Agency and the Lower Colorado River Basin Development Fund.

The bill requires the use of competitive procedures for management and operating contracts at the Department of Energy.

The bill prevents the use of funds to develop or implement a workforce restructuring plan that covers the Department of Energy or that provides enhanced severance payments or other benefits for employees.

EARMARKS:

The Committee Report normally earmarks funding for projects that are not requested by the Administration. The Committee continues this practice this year.
