Page I-A-28, line 3, strike "REPORT CARDS.—"
and insert "REPORTS.—".

Page I-A-28, line 11, strike "A State that pub-
lishes" and all that follows through "part." on line 18
and insert the following: "States and local educational
agencies may issue report cards under this section only
for local educational agencies and schools receiving funds
under this part, except that if a State or local educational
agency issues a report card for all students, the State or
local educational agency may include the information
under this section as part of such report card."

Page I-A-28, line 19, strike "shall" and all that fol-
lows through "be" on line 22 and insert the following:
"shall ensure the dissemination of this information at all
levels. Such information shall be".

Page I-A-29, line 3, strike "(C)" and all that fol-
lows through the period on line 9 and insert the fol-
lowing:

- 1 “(C) PUBLIC DISSEMINATION.—In the
- 2 event the State does not include such informa-



1 tion through a report card, the State shall, not
 2 later than the beginning of the 2001-2002
 3 school year, publicly report the information de-
 4 scribed in paragraph (2) through other public
 5 means, such as posting on the Internet, dis-
 6 tribution to the media, and distribution through
 7 public agencies, for all schools that receive
 8 funds under this part.

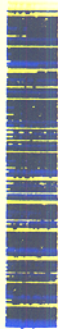
Page I-A-31, line 22, strike "report cards" and in-
 sert "reports".

Page I-A-32, line 2, strike "card" and insert "for
 each school that receives funds under this part".

Page I-A-33, strike lines 4 through 8 and insert the
 following:

9 “(B) OTHER INFORMATION.—A local edu-
 10 cational agency may include in its annual report
 11 any other appropriate information whether or
 12 not such information is included in the annual
 13 State report.

Page I-A-33, strike lines 9 through 14 and insert
 the following:



1 “(C) PUBLIC DISSEMINATION.—In the
2 event the local educational agency does not in-
3 clude such information through a report card,
4 the local educational agency shall, not later
5 than the beginning of the 2001-2002 school
6 year, publicly report the information described
7 in paragraph (3) through other public means,
8 such as posting on the Internet, distribution to
9 the media, and distribution through public
10 agencies, only for schools that receive funds
11 under this part, except that if a local edu-
12 cational agency issues a report card for all stu-
13 dents, the local educational agency may include
14 the information under this section as part of
15 such report.

Page I-A-33, line 16, strike “and report cards”.

Page I-A-33, line 24, strike “LOCAL REPORTS” and
insert “LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCY REPORTS”.

Page I-A-33, line 25, strike “report cards” and in-
sert “reports”.

Page I-A-34, line 1, after “schools” insert “receiv-
ing funds under this part,”

Page I-A-34, strike lines 7 through 12.
