**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3077
OFFERED BY MR. HOLT OF NEW JERSEY**

At the end of the Amendment, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 8. NATIONAL STUDY OF FOREIGN LANGUAGE HERIT-**
2 **AGE COMMUNITIES.**

3 Part D of title VI is further amended by inserting
4 after section 635 (as added by section 7) the following
5 new section:

6 **“SEC. 636. NATIONAL STUDY OF FOREIGN LANGUAGE HER-**
7 **ITAGE COMMUNITIES.**

8 **“(a) STUDY.—**The Secretary of Education, in con-
9 sultation with the International Advisory Board, shall con-
10 duct a study to identify foreign language heritage commu-
11 nities, particularly such communities that include speakers
12 of languages that are critical to the national security of
13 the United States.

14 **“(b) FOREIGN LANGUAGE HERITAGE COMMUNITY.—**
15 For purposes of this section, the term ‘foreign language
16 heritage community’ means a community of residents or
17 citizens of the United States who are native speakers of,
18 or who have partial fluency in, a foreign language.



1 “(c) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
2 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Education
3 shall submit a report to the Congress on the results of
4 the study conducted under this section.”.

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3077
OFFERED BY MR. HOLT OF NEW JERSEY**

In section 2 of the amendment, after subsection (b) insert the following new subsection (and redesignate the succeeding subsections accordingly):

1 (c) LANGUAGE RESOURCE CENTERS.—Section
2 602(a)(2) (20 U.S.C. 1123) is amended—

3 (1) by striking “and” at the end of subpara-
4 graph (G);

5 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-
6 paragraph (H) and inserting “; and”; and

7 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
8 paragraph:

9 “(I) projects that support in students an
10 understanding of science and technology in co-
11 ordination with foreign language proficiency.”.
