Finance Committee Approves Nominations of Fratto, Spooner, Bohigian, Crowder

WASHINGTON — Senate Finance Committee Members today voted in S-216 of the Capitol to approve four nominations.

Committee Members voted yes for each nominee, with the exception of Sen. Kent Conrad voting no on the nomination of Richard T. Crowder. Sens. Bill Frist, Kent Conrad and John Kerry voted by proxy on each nomination.

- David Steele Bohigian, Assistant Secretary of Commerce, Market Access and Compliance, U.S. Department of Commerce, Washington, DC
- Richard T. Crowder, to be Chief Agricultural Negotiator, Office of the United States Trade Representative, Washington, DC.
