about Medicare Prescription Drug Coverage

1 Make the deadline.

May 15 is the deadline to sign up for the new Medicare Prescription Drug benefit. Enrollment is voluntary, but if you don't have prescription drug coverage or you are looking for better coverage, the new benefit is worth considering. Anyone who is eligible for Medicare is eligible to enroll in the program.

2 Call for help.

Help is available for reviewing plans and signing up. Call **1-800-MEDICARE (800-633-4227)** or take advantage of Medicare's online enrollment center at **www.medicare.gov**. Simply enter the prescription drugs you regularly take, and it will tell you which plan is best for your needs. If you are having problems, call my office toll-free at **1-800-862-8632**.

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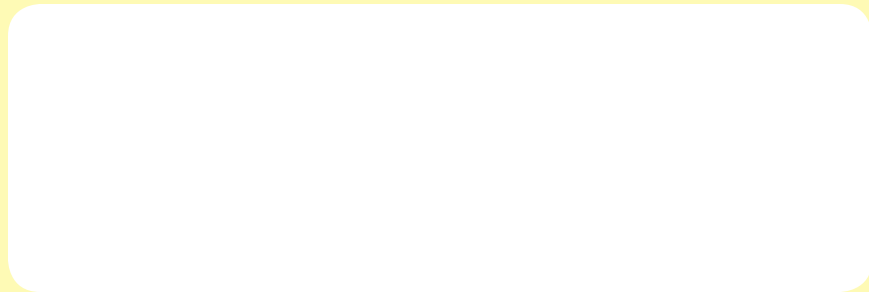
