## Republican Reconciliation Spending Cuts Bill Will Cause...

- 13 million people to pay higher costs for their medical care, including 4.5 million children.
- 20 million people to pay higher costs for their prescription drugs, including 6.6 million children.
- At least 65,000 people to lose Medicaid coverage because they cannot afford higher premiums.
- Benefit cuts for 1.6 million adults. The numbers will be even higher when children are included.
- Loss of long-term care coverage for 130,000 people.

## Negotiating Drug Prices Would Save Money for Medicare

- HHS could negotiate lower prices if it was allowed to harness the purchasing power of over 44 million Medicare beneficiaries.
- Secretary Thompson has said, "I would like to have had the opportunity to negotiate [drug prices]."
- During the Anthrax scare, Secretary Thompson negotiated a $46 \%$ discount off of Bayer's original price for Cipro.
- In 2003, HHS negotiated a discount of over 50\% for FluMist.
- GAO found that average VA-negotiated prices are 50 lower than the average manufacturer's prices.
