16 **SEC. 306. RESERVE FUND TO ACCOMMODATE FULLY OFF-**
17 **SET APPROPRIATIONS FOR LABOR/HHS, EDU-**
18 **CATION, AND OTHER DOMESTIC PRIORITIES.**

19 In the House, if any measure is enacted that reduces
20 direct spending for fiscal year 2007 and for the period
21 of fiscal years 2007 through 2011, and so designates some



1 or all of such savings provisions pursuant to this section,
2 then the chairman of the Committee on Budget shall in-
3 crease the allocation of new budget authority (and outlays
4 flowing therefrom) to the Committee on Appropriations
5 for fiscal year 2007 by an amount not to exceed the reduc-
6 tion in budget authority for that fiscal year achieved by
7 such designated provisions. Adjustments made pursuant
8 to this section may not be—

9 (1) greater than the savings achieved by the
10 measure in which such designated provisions are in-
11 cluded; or

12 (2) in excess of \$3,100,000,000 for fiscal year
13 2007.

14 Such chairman may make any other appropriate adjust-
15 ments to applicable aggregates and allocations under this
16 section.

Amend the section heading of section 402 to read as follows: **“CONTINGENCY OPERATIONS RELATED TO THE GLOBAL WAR ON TERRORISM AND FOR UNANTICIPATED DEFENSE NEEDS”**.

Amend the side heading of section 402(a) to read as follows: **“EXEMPTION OF CONTINGENCY OPERATIONS RELATED TO THE GLOBAL WAR ON TERRORISM AND FOR UNANTICIPATED DEFENSE NEEDS.—”**.

Amend section 501 to read as follows:

1 **SEC. 501. NONDEFENSE RESERVE FUND FOR EMER-**
2 **GENCIES.**

3 (a) NONDEFENSE RESERVE FUNDS.—

4 (1) DISCRETIONARY RESERVE FUND.—In the
5 House and except as provided by subsection (b), if
6 a bill or joint resolution is reported, or an amend-
7 ment is offered thereto (or considered as adopted) or
8 a conference report is filed thereon, that provides
9 new discretionary budget authority (and outlays
10 flowing therefrom), and such provision is designated
11 as an emergency pursuant to this section, the chair-
12 man of the Committee on the Budget shall make ad-
13 justments to the allocations and aggregates set forth
14 in this resolution up to the amount of such provi-
15 sions if the requirements set forth in section 504 are
16 met, but the sum of all adjustments made under this
17 paragraph shall not exceed \$6,450,000,000 for fiscal
18 year 2007.



19 (2) OTHER ADJUSTMENTS.—In the House, if a
20 bill or joint resolution is reported or a conference re-
21 port is filed thereon, and a direct spending or receipt
22 provision included therein is designated as an emer-
23 gency pursuant to this paragraph, the chairman of

1 the Committee on the Budget may make adjust-
2 ments to the allocations and aggregates set forth in
3 this resolution.

4 (b) ADDITIONAL ADJUSTMENT PROCEDURES.—In
5 the House, before any adjustment is made pursuant to
6 this section for any bill, joint resolution, or conference re-
7 port that designates a provision an emergency, the enact-
8 ment of which would cause the total amount of the reserve
9 fund set forth in subsection (a)(1) for fiscal year 2007
10 to be exceeded:

11 (1) The chairman of the Committee on the
12 Budget shall convene a meeting of that committee,
13 where it shall be in order, subject to the terms set
14 forth in this section, for one motion described in
15 paragraph (2) to be made to authorize the chairman
16 to make adjustments above the maximum amount of
17 adjustments set forth in subsection (a).

18 (2) The motion referred to in paragraph (1)
19 shall be in the following form: 'I move that the
20 chairman of the Committee on the Budget be au-
21 thorized to adjust the allocations and aggregates set
22 forth in the concurrent resolution on the budget for
23 fiscal year 2007 by the following amount: \$_____

24 for fiscal year 2007.', with the blank being filled in
25 with amount determined by the chairman of the



1 Committee on the Budget. For any measure referred
2 to in subsection (a)(1), such amount shall not exceed
3 the total amount for fiscal year 2007 designated as
4 an emergency in excess of the applicable amount re-
5 maining in the reserve fund.

6 (3) The motion set forth in paragraph (2) shall
7 be open for debate and amendment, but any amend-
8 ment offered thereto is only in order if limited to
9 changing an amount in the motion.

10 (4) Except as provided by paragraph (5), the
11 chairman of the Committee on the Budget may not
12 make any adjustments under subsection (a) or sub-
13 section (b) unless or until the committee filing a re-
14 port or joint statement of managers on a conference
15 report on a measure including an emergency des-
16 ignation fulfills the terms set forth in section 504.

17 (5) The chairman of the Committee on the
18 Budget shall make any adjustments he deems nec-
19 essary under this section if he determines the enact-
20 ment of the provision or provisions designated as an
21 emergency is essential to respond to an urgent and
22 imminent need, the chairman determines the excep-
23 tional circumstances referred to in rule 3 of the
24 rules of the committee are met and the committee



1 cannot convene to consider the motion referred to in
2 this section in a timely fashion.

3 (c) APPLICATION OF ADJUSTMENTS.—The adjust-
4 ments made pursuant to subsection (a) or (b) shall—

5 (1) apply while that bill, joint resolution, con-
6 ference report or amendment is under consideration;

7 (2) take effect upon the enactment of that leg-
8 islation; and

9 (3) be published in the Congressional Record as
10 soon as practicable.
