- 1 Section 234A of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 (42
- 2 U.S.C. 2282a) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 3 lowing new subsection:
- 4 "e. The Secretary may, notwithstanding any other
- 5 provision of law, exercise any authority under this section
- 6 through the Assistant Secretary of Energy for Environ-
- 7 ment, Safety, and Health.".
