A good source just told me that there was a meeting with POTUS about 29 potential court of appeals nominees. Some were approved; some were deferred; some were rejected. As it is told to me, rejections tended to be related to questions about how solidly conservative they were; deferrals had to do with lack of Senator support or conflict with the preference of home state senator.

Importantly, the source indicated that the belief is that Democrats and interest groups are planning on attacking a significant number of court of appeals nominees, and that they are expecting to lose 3-4 nominees out of this first batch. The source indicated that confirmability and issues related to it were a heavy subject of discussion.
