Eligibility

The law pertaining to Congressional academies. nominations for each of the service academies stipulates that each Member of Congress is allowed a maximum of five persons at each academy during any given year. This allocation to the academies determines the number of vacancies for each entering class. We are authorized to nominate up to ten individuals for each vacancy in the entering class. Since the process is so competitive, we recommend that candidates apply to Congressmen, both U.S. Senators, and the Vice President. The Merchant Marine allocation system is the exception to this guideline.

The regulations of the Air Force, Army and Naval Academies require that a nominee reside in the state of the nominating Senator. If you should move out of the state during the application process, you should notify this office immediately so your file can be transferred to the proper Congressional office.

Nominees to the service academies must be permanent residents of Minnesota and United States citizens. Canplication directly to the Coast Guard didates must be at least 17 years old and not past their 23rd birthday. Merdidates until their 25th birthday. Candidates cannot be married and must not have dependents. These stipulations have been established by the service



Method of Nomination

Senator Coleman uses the "Competitive" form of nomination to the service academies. Using this method. the Senator submits to each academy unranked nominees for each vacancy. The academy then reviews the nominees and selects the candidates it deems If you have not already done so, you most qualified.

If an applicant has a parent who is an active or retired military person, or a parent who is a disabled or deceased veteran, he/she should review the instructions in the service academy literature to learn of additional means of receiving a nomination.

Application Process

The application process for an academy nomination is challenging. We recommend beginning the process during the spring of your junior year in high school.

After an application has been completed, it must be returned to the mailing address, as noted below.

The following materials need to be submitted, no later than October 15th of each year.

- 1. A completed Application for Nomination, including a recent photograph.
- 2. High school transcripts.
- 3. Three letters of recommendation, written by individuals who are very familiar with the applicant. These may be written by teachers, coaches, employers, clergy, veterans, neighbors or other non family members who could accurately comment on an applicant's The difficulties and complexities of the character, abilities, motivation and potential.
- and/or ACT scores. 4. SAT These are acceptable from the high school transcripts.

Academy Advisory **Committee**

Upon receipt of your entire application for nomination, it will be reviewed. If it is completed by October 15th, and you appear qualified, an interview will be scheduled when our Academy Advisory Committee meets in November. We will accept updated test scores or other new documentation at that time. You will be notified in January about the status of your nomination.
