- 2 HEATING OR HOME ENERGY GENERATION.
- 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsection (b), an In-
- 4 dian tribe may authorize, without any review or approval
- 5 by any agency of the United States, itself or agencies or
- 6 instrumentalities of the tribal government or an enrolled
- 7 member of that Indian tribe to harvest any tree, wood,
- 8 woody debris, or similar material on land owned by the
- 9 tribe (including land held in trust by the United States
- 10 for the benefit of the tribe) for personal home heating or
- 11 home energy generation in homes located on that tribe's
- 12 land.
- 13 (b) Terms; Release of Liability.—A tribal au-
- 14 thorization under subsection (a) shall be subject to the
- 15 terms and conditions of an appropriate tribal law, ordi-
- 16 nance or regulation, and shall release the United States



- 1 from any liability arising from such tribal law, ordinance
- 2 or regulation, or any action arising therefrom.
- 3 (c) Definition.—For the purpose of this section,
- 4 the term "Indian tribe" means any federally recognized
- 5 tribe, band, pueblo, or community in the contiguous 48
- 6 states and the Metlakatla Indian Community in Alaska
