AMENDMENT TO H.R. 503 OFFERED BY MR. CONAWAY

This amendment to H.R. 503 would require the Secretary to compensate any horse owner who, no longer having the option of selling a horse for processing, suffers a loss in value of his horse and incurs the cost of euthanasia and disposal of the horse.

Page 5, after line 7 insert the following new subsection (and redesignate subsection (e) as subsection (f)):

- 4 "Sec. 11. The Secretary shall compensate the owner
- 5 of an equine who disposes of such equine due to the prohi-
- 6 bition under section 5(8). The Secretary shall compensate
- 7 such owner for the total amount of—
- 8 "(1) the loss in value of the equine due to such
- 9 prohibition; and
- 10 "(2) the costs incurred in the disposal of such
- 11 equine.".
