Johnson Advises 5th District Families with Relatives in Lebanon to Contact Her Office

Two Johnson Aides Have Been Helping Evacuate Americans for Past Week

NEW BRITAIN, CT – Congresswoman Nancy Johnson today advised constituents to contact her office with concerns about loved ones in Lebanon. Over the course of the past week, two Johnson aides have been working with 5th District families to contact relatives in Lebanon and evacuate them from the country.

“Our top priority right now is helping 5th District families contact loved ones in Lebanon and get them to safety,” Johnson said. “My office has been working full-time with Connecticut families and with State Department officials over the past week. I urge anyone in the 5th District concerned about someone in Lebanon to contact my office so we can help. I hope for a quick end to the conflict and the safety of those in harm’s way.”

Johnson staffers have helped connect Connecticut families with relatives in the region and assisted their evacuation. They continue to work with others seeking to evacuate and return home to their families.
