Banning partial-birth abortion should not be the last victory for the unborn.

- ➤ Banning partial-birth abortion is a tremendous victory for the unborn, protecting them from one of the most barbaric procedures that has ever been allowed in America.
- ➤ But more victories must be won to advance a culture in which life in America is defended at every stage of development.
- ➤ One such advancement would come by enacting the Unborn Victims of Violence Act, which would make a perpetrator of a violent attack on a pregnant mother guilty under the federal criminal code for two separate offenses—one against the mother and one against the unborn baby.
- Another such advancement would come by enacting the RU-486 Suspension and Review Act, which would immediately suspend the FDA's approval of the abortion drug RU-486 and indefinitely suspend the approval of RU-486 if it is determined that the FDA violated its own approval protocols for this awful drug.

Clearly,	the fight to	protect the	unborn must	continue u	nabated.
