 $<sup>^2</sup>$  The House-Senate conference committee reported out a bill with an NEA line-item of \$126.264 million, but the bill also included a 0.476 percent across-the-board cut for the entire bill which brings the total amount appropriated for the NEA in FY06 to \$125.663 million.
