A BILL

- To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to deliver a meaningful benefit and lower prescription drug prices under the Medicare Program.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Prescription

5 Drug Savings and Choice Act of 2004".

1SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF MEDICARE OPERATED PRE-2SCRIPTION DRUG PLAN OPTION.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subpart 2 of part D of the Social
4 Security Act, as added by section 101 of the Medicare Pre5 scription Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act of
6 2003 (Public Law 108–173), is amended by inserting
7 after section 1860D–11 the following new section:

8 "MEDICARE OPERATED PRESCRIPTION DRUG PLAN

10 "SEC. 1860D–11A. (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwith-11 standing any other provision of this part, for each year 12 (beginning with 2006), in addition to any plans offered 13 under section 1860D–11, the Secretary shall offer one or 14 more medicare operated prescription drug plans (as de-15 fined in subsection (c)) with a service area that consists of the entire United States and shall enter into negotia-16 tions with pharmaceutical manufacturers to reduce the 17 18 purchase cost of covered part D drugs for eligible part 19 D individuals in accordance with subsection (b).

20 "(b) **NEGOTIATIONS.**—Notwithstanding section 21 1860D–11(i), for purposes of offering a medicare operated 22 prescription drug plan under this section, the Secretary 23 shall negotiate with pharmaceutical manufacturers with 24 respect to the purchase price of covered part D drugs and shall encourage the use of more affordable therapeutic 25 equivalents to the extent such practices do not override 26

medical necessity as determined by the prescribing physi cian. To the extent practicable and consistent with the
 previous sentence, the Secretary shall implement strate gies similar to those used by other Federal purchasers of
 prescription drugs, and other strategies, to reduce the pur chase cost of covered part D drugs.

7 "(c) MEDICARE OPERATED PRESCRIPTION DRUG 8 PLAN DEFINED.—For purposes of this part, the term 9 'medicare operated prescription drug plan' means a pre-10 scription drug plan that offers qualified prescription drug 11 coverage and access to negotiated prices described in sec-12 tion 1860D-2(a)(1)(A). Such a plan may offer supple-13 mental prescription drug coverage in the same manner as other qualified prescription drug coverage offered by other 14 15 prescription drug plans.

16 "(d) MONTHLY BENEFICIARY PREMIUM.—

"(1) QUALIFIED PRESCRIPTION DRUG COV-17 18 ERAGE.—The monthly beneficiary premium for 19 qualified prescription drug coverage and access to 20 negotiated prices described in section 1860D-21 2(a)(1)(A) to be charged under a medicare operated 22 prescription drug plan shall be uniform nationally. 23 Such premium for months in 2006 shall be \$35 and 24 for months in succeeding years shall be based on the 25 average monthly per capita actuarial cost of offering
