## JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States relating to parental rights.

1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives

2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled

3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-

4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several
8 States within seven years after the date of its submission
9 for ratification:

## "ARTICLE —

2 "SECTION 1. The liberty of parents to direct the up-3 bringing and education of their children is a fundamental4 right.

5 "SECTION 2. Neither the United States nor any State
6 shall infringe upon this right without demonstrating that
7 its governmental interest as applied to the person is of
8 the highest order and not otherwise served.

9 "SECTION 3. No treaty may be adopted nor shall any 10 source of international law be employed to supersede, mod-11 ify, interpret, or apply to the rights guaranteed by this 12 article.".
