Recent Votes by Congressman Scott:

... H.R. 6 - Creating Long-Term Energy Alternatives for the Nation Act

The bill would repeal \$14 billion in subsidies given to Big Oil companies that are raking in record profits over 10 years and invest those funds in clean, renewable energy and energy efficiency.

DS voted FOR HR 6; HR 6 passed 264-163 (1-18-07)

H.R. 5 - College Student Relief Act

The bill would make college more affordable and accessible by cutting the interest rate on subsidized student loans for undergraduates in half over the next five years – reducing the interest rate from the current 6.8 percent to 3.4 percent..

DS voted FOR HR 5; HR 5 passed 356-71 (1-17-07)

... H.R. 4 - Medicare Prescription Drug Act

This is a bipartisan bill aimed at cutting prescription drug prices for millions of seniors and individuals with disabilities by enabling the Secretary of Health and Human Services to negotiate for lower-cost drugs.

DS voted FOR HR 4; HR4 passed the House 255-170 (1-12-07)

B H.R. 3 - Stem Cell Research Enhancement Act

This bill expands federal funding for embryonic stem cell research, giving hope to 100 million Americans affected by debilitating or life-threatening diseases and their families.

35 DS voted FOR HR 3; HR 3 passed 253-174 (1-11-07)


B. H.R. 2 - Fair Minimum Wage Act

This bill increases the minimum wage from \$5.15 to \$7.25 an hour over two years. Increasing the minimum wage to \$7.25 per hour would bring a pay raise for up to 13 million Americans.

DS voted FOR H.R. 2, which passed the House 315-116 (1-10-07)

B H.R. 1 - Implementing the 9/11 Commission Recommendations Act

This bill implements the bipartisan 9/11 Commission's recommendations to improve homeland security and prevent terrorists from acquiring weapons of mass



B DS voted FOR H.R. 1, which passed the House 299-128 (1-9-07)
