4 **MODIFIED STANDARDS FOR STUDENTS WITH** 5 **DISABILITIES.**

6 Section 1111(b)(1) of the Elementary and Secondary
7 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6311(b)(1)) is amended
8 by striking subparagraph (B) and inserting the following:

1	"(B) SAME STANDARDS.—
2	"(i) IN GENERAL.—The academic
3	standards required by subparagraph (A)
4	shall be the same academic standards that
5	the State applies to all schools and chil-
6	dren in the State, except as provided in
7	clause (ii).
8	"(ii) Students with disabil-
9	ITIES.—The State may apply alternate and
10	modified academic standards to students
11	with disabilities who, consistent with the
12	student's individualized education program,
13	and based on the student's disability and
14	level of performance, should be provided
15	opportunities to achieve grade-level pro-
16	ficiency beyond a given school year. The al-
17	ternate and modified academic standards
18	shall reflect ambitious annual goals for at-
19	tainment by the students with disabil-
20	ities.".
