
Dear Mr. Leverty:

Sterling Boulevard in Sterling Park, Virginia at the request of the Loudoun County Board of Supervisors and Sheriff Simpson. As you know, this property was the scene of a violent crime earlier this year and continues to be of grave concern to the residents of Sterling Park.

I was told that you and the Gelman family have been contacted on several occasions regarding the enforcement of loitering laws on your property. It is my understanding that on weekends the loitering on the property is out of control and unacceptable. No resident should be afraid to visit any business establishments in Sterling Park or elsewhere in the county.

In light of the recent crime activity on and around your property, I respectfully request that you and the Gelman family work with the Board of Supervisors and Sheriff to address this urgent concern and ensure that loitering laws are enforced. As the property manager, it is your responsibility and obligation to see that property is well maintained and visitor safety is protected.
