To ensure completeness of your application, candidates are required to set up an appointment with Rebecca Hartmann or Shawna Rimke of my district office staff, any day between October 17 and October 31,2005, to review their file.

Each candidate has no less than four nominating resources available to them. The medical waiver process may be very time consuming, and there are a limited number of medical waivers available, which are generally granted on a first come, first served basis, For additional information on medical waivers, please contact your Liaison Officer or the Admissions office at the academy to which you have applied.

Finally, while I appreciate the interest and support of the parents, and welcome any general questions they may have with regard to the academies, telephone calls specific to the candidate's application will not be accepted from any party other than the candidate.
