Rush Holt – Your Representative in Congress

Dear Friend,

This past year – the ninth in which I have been privileged to serve as your representative – marked a change in Congress, with a new majority and new leadership. For my part, I have remained committed to the principles and constituent service for which you first sent me to Washington, DC.

This report – including the map – will provide a sampling of my work on behalf of the 12th Congressional District: voting on legislation in Congress on behalf of the 700,000 residents of Central New Jersey, giving public voice to their concerns, highlighting their successes and challenges, and helping individuals with specific problems they encounter with the federal bureaucracy. It includes, for example, securing \$26.8 million in new funding for defense efforts at Fort Monmouth, obtaining grants to local first responders and school districts, and holding town hall meetings across the district.

I have supported a number of initiatives that Congress enacted into law this year: implementation of the 9/11 Commission recommendations, raising the minimum wage for the first time in a decade, providing the largest college aid expansion since the GI Bill of 1944, allocating funding to treat soldiers for traumatic brain injury and post traumatic stress disorder, and establishing much-needed ethics and lobbying reform.

We still have much to do in the new year, including making a long-overdue course change in Iraq, enacting election reform, providing tax relief to middle class families, and renewing the Children's Health Insurance Program.


