Each year I nominate qualified graduating high school seniors from the 12th Congressional District for appointment to the U.S. Military, Naval, Air Force and Merchant Marine Academies. The U.S. Coast Guard Academy does not require a nomination. Each Congressional office has his or her method for selecting nominees. My Congressional office uses the Principal with Numbered Alternates method.

My Academy Selection Committee interviews each applicant. A nomination is based on SAT/ACT scores, class rank, physical aptitude scores, extracurricular activities, physical fitness, medical examination and letters of recommendation. **The deadline for submitting a completed application to my office is November 1, 2008.**

Each applicant for a nomination must meet the following basic eligibility requirements by July 1st of the year you seek admission to an academy.

- Must be a United States citizen.
- Must be between the ages of 17 and 23.
- Must be unmarried.
- Must have no legal obligation to support children or other dependents.

- 3. Three Letters of recommendation. One must be from English instructor, one must be a mathematics instructor, and one may be from another individual, other than a relative. Please submit no more that three letters of recommendation.
- 4. A transcript of your high school grades, including verification of your class rank.
- 5. A small photograph of yourself

The above items must reach my Greensboro office no later that November 1, 2008. Unless all items are received by this date, the Academy Screening Committee will be unable to consider your application for a nomination.
