- House Republicans have transformed their “all-of-the-above” energy strategy into a single piece of legislation: **the American Energy Act**, which will be introduced today at a rally on the West Front Steps of the U.S. Capitol.
- The bill – a product made possible by energy policies proposed by Members throughout the House Republican Conference – will increase the supply of American-made energy, improve conservation and efficiency, and promote new and expanding energy technologies to help lower the price at the pump and reduce America’s increasingly costly and dangerous dependence on foreign sources of energy.
- While Democratic leaders continue to block a vote on any meaningful solutions to help lower energy costs, it’s clear that bipartisan passage of the American Energy Act would demonstrate to the world that America will no longer keep its rich energy resources under lock-and-key. Not only will it help bring down the price of gasoline now, but it will make needed investments in the alternative fuels that will power our lives and our economy in the future.
