CONSTITUENT SERVICES

Please call one of my offices for help with the following <u>services:</u>

Social Security/Medicare Assistance

- Check on the status of your pending Social Security application for benefits, trace missing payments, check on overpayment problems, and check the status of existing disability claims.
- Answer questions regarding Medicare Part A and Medicare Part B and follow up on Part B applications with Social Security.

Veteran Services

- Follow up on pending applications for Veterans Affairs pensions, service-connected disability benefits, rating increases, and/or an appeal on a previous decision by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA).
- Help you obtain grave markers and burial flags for the deceased, and put you in touch with the VA Memorial Network who can assist in having a deceased veteran laid to rest in a VA Cemetery.

Passports, Visas, & Immigration



- Help you obtain passports in emergency situations.
- Check on the status of your pending immigration application and help you obtain the necessary forms from the United States Citizenship and Information Services.

Military Personnel

 Assist you and your family members with obtaining service records (including medical records) and replacement medals awarded during military service.

Academy Appointments

 I nominate students each year for admission to the U.S. service academies: Army, Navy, Air Force, and Merchant Marine. Applications are available on my web page.

Flag Flown Over The Capitol

 I can have flags flown over the Capitol to mark special occasions. 4-6 weeks notice is needed. Flag order form: www.house.gov/tauscher

Federal Grants Assistance

- Assist with grant information, including providing a regular email newsletter about federal grants.
- Submit a letter of support and facilitate grant applicants' inquiries to the awarding federal agencies.

Youth Program

- My office offers unpaid internship opportunities for college students in both my Washington, D.C. and Walnut Creek offices.
- My office participates in the high school Congressional Art Competition. The winner receives three airplane tickets to DC to attend the awards program.
