## **Alexander, Vitter Announce Grant Funding for Downsville**

(Washington D.C.) – U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander and U.S. Sen. David Vitter announced today that the Village of Downsville will receive a Land and Water Conservation grant award totaling \$150,000 for the Bryan Park project.

The funding will be used to acquire 35 acres to develop into picnic areas, trails and support facilities.

"With this grant from the National Park Service, residents of Downsville and other communities nearby can better enjoy and appreciate the beautiful nature this area has to offer," Alexander said.
