Alexander, Vitter Announce Grant Funding for Catahoula Parish

(Washington D.C.) – U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander and U.S. Sen. David Vitter announced today that Catahoula Parish Law Enforcement District will receive a USDA Rural Development grant totaling \$50,000.

The funding will be used to purchase a new fully equipped patrol unit and K-9 dog.

“Keeping rural officers equipped with modern patrol cars is a central need for areas such as Catahoula Parish,” Alexander said. “This grant will ensure officers in this region will be ready and able to respond quickly in emergency law enforcement situations as well as in their daily efforts to serve the community.”

“The additional resources made possible by this grant will go a long way to helping keep Catahoula residents safe,” said Vitter. “They can now rest assured that their families have access to the same protections they would have in larger cities.”
