Alexander Announces Funding for Goodwill Volunteer Fire District

WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander, R-Quitman, today announced the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) will award \$12,255 from the Assistance to Firefighters Grants (AFG) program to the Goodwill Volunteer Fire District.
