CDF Action Council Rates Abercrombie Among 'Best' to Protect Children

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- The Children's Defense Fund Action Council has rated U.S. Representative Neil Abercrombie as one of the best lawmakers based on his votes to protect children.

Abercrombie earned a 100% rating on ten key issues reviewed by the Council.

"Our children have always been my most important 'special interest' and I intend to continue to do all I can to provide them every opportunity for a bright future," said Abercrombie.

The CDF Action Council compiles the Nonpartisan Congressional Scorecard each year. The 2007 scorecard rated Members of Congress according to their votes on:

- 1. Supporting Pay-As-You-Go Rules for Taxes and Spending
- 2. Increasing the Minimum Wage
- 3. Supporting the 2008 Budget Resolution
- 4. Protecting Children from Unsafe Medications
- 5. Extending Health Coverage to 4.1 million Uninsured Children
- 6. Helping Youth Pay for College
- 7. Extending Health Coverage to 3.1 million Uninsured Children (The pared-back legislation was re-introduced and passed following President Bush's veto. He vetoed it a second time.)
- 8. Funding for Child Health and Education
- 9. Supporting Tax Relief for Low-Income Families with Children
- 10. Expanding the Head Start program
